General guidance

Restaurants are quite aware of gluten free, but there are not many carbohydrate substitutes available so take supplies of bread and crackers. There is a health food shop & supermarket in Reykjavik that has GF supplies (see shops at end) and you are recommended to stock up there or in Akureyri for a long road trip.

Hotel breakfast

You should be able to get hard boiled eggs, smoked salmon, tomato, cucumber, cheese and gluten free yoghurt (Skyr brand).

Laugavegur is the main shopping strip. I have added downtown/uptown to the location where known.
