

## Restaurant Search Iceland - Reykjavik April 2014 v1.1

## General guidance

Restaurants are quite aware of gluten free, but there are not many carbohydrate substitutes available so take supplies of bread and crackers. There is a health food shop & supermarket in Rejkavik that has GF supplies (see shops at end) and you are recommended to stock up there or in Akureyri for a long road trip.

## Hotel breakfast

You should be able to get hard boiled eggs, smoked salmon, tomato, cucumber, cheese and gluten free yoghurt (Skyr brand).

Laugavegur is the main shopping strip. I have added downtown/uptown to the location where known.
